

Pedersen Realty Website Homeowners Association Options

Option One

Password-protected HOA pages

- 1. Create a unique password protected page for each HOA
- 2. Distribute password to whomever needs access

Pros:

Simple to setup new HOAs

Cons:

• A new password must be generated and distributed when an HOA member with access leaves.

Option Two

Require individual users to register and login to view private HOA-specific page(s)

Pros:

- Access is controlled at the user level. Access can be revoked at any time without affecting the other HOA memmbers.
- Content may be more secure.

Cons:

There are additional steps required to authorize users and to make content private.



Registering Users

Option One

HOA members register online

- 1. Clicks Register link on the Login page.
- 2. Fills out and submits info form.
- 3. System sends Pedersen Realty a New-User Notification by email.
- 4. Pedersen Realty reviews the request and, if warranted, the user is enabled and is assigned to an HOA.
- 5. The system sends an email to the user indicating that their account is now active.

Option Two

Pedersen Realty sets up new users manually

- 1. User can fill out an online login request form to obtain login credentials.
- 2. The system emails the form to Pedersen Realty.
- 3. Pedersen Realty sets up the new user by assigning a username, password and HOA.
- 4. The system sends an email to the new user with his or her login credentials.
